Memorial University Entrance Requirements

Below is a guide to calculating the entrance requirements for admission into Memorial University of Newfoundland. Students must obtain a **70% average (or 700 points)** in **ten** 3000 Level credits as follows:

Additional requirements:

Although not used for calculating the average, students must have completed the following courses: Math 2204 or Math 2205 **and** 4 credits in a Laboratory Science (i.e. courses in C above at the 2000 or 3000 level or Science 1206)

****If the highest mark in the 3000 level credit is a 1 credit course and the next highest is a 2 credit 3000 level course, then both courses will be used but the two credit course mark will not be multiplied by 2.**

Please note as well that other careers and other post-secondary institutions (CNA, and other Colleges/Universities outside Newfoundland) have specific requirements that may differ from the entrance requirements for Memorial University. These should be checked carefully with the Guidance Office.
